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Detailed Design of Battlefords Multipurpose Facility Unveiled

North Battleford City Council has received the detailed design of the four separate components to be included in the Battlefords Multipurpose Facility. Barr Ryder Architects and Interior Designers, commissioned by the City of North Battleford last year, presented the designs during a City Council meeting last night.

“This has been years in the making and it’s amazing to finally be at this stage of the project today,” said North Battleford Mayor, Ian Hamilton. “It is most fitting and apt that we receive this during the last Council meeting of 2009 – what a great way to go into 2010.”

The four components will include an Aquatic Facility (2 waterslides, 6 lane competition pool, wave pool), Performance Theatre (seating for 350), Curling Rink (6 sheets of ice, lounge) and Flex Fieldhouse (2 soccer pitches, seating for 250 per field). The total estimated cost for the entire project is approximately \$49.8 million including contingency costs.

“Now that we have the detailed design, local contractors will be among those who will have the opportunity to bid once the tenders go out in the spring,” said City Manager, Jim Toye.

The City of North Battleford anticipates construction proceeding no later than the end of May 2010.

The detailed design of all four components will be set up in the lobby of North Battleford City Hall.
